This old song has been playing in my mind over the last few months. Just as many of you have been restricted in your

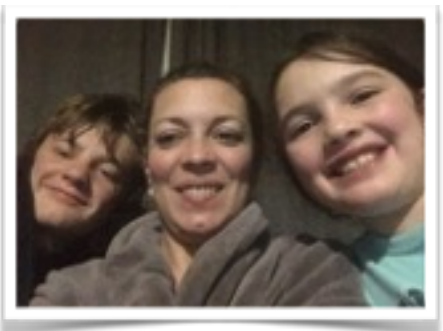
